- ♦ The Golf Shop understands that athletic clothing is reaching all new demographics, we would like to remind everyone that new Under amour, Nike, and Adidas shirts must have an 1 ½ inch collar on them to be considered a Golf shirt. Please refer to the Dress Code in your Membership booklet to alleviate all questions.
- ♦ Look for the return of the Late-Tees Thursday biweekly golf to be finalized in the May news.
- ♦ Jeans are not permitted on the course following March 31st.
- ♦ Please be aware that the parking lot speed limit is 15 miles per hour, my young

men and women are in the lot trying to service you with your bags and carts, please be aware.

The Golf Shop will open at 9am weekdays until April 15th, on the 16th we will begin opening on the weekdays at 7:30 and Tee-Times will begin at 8am. We will continue to open at 7:30 on the weekends until Memorial Day when the Golf Shop will begin to open at 6:30; we are trying to accommodate players that wish to get out on the course earlier. We will continue to monitor the effects of the early opening.

Hole In One-the HIO insurance will be once again in effect this season. The insurance is \$10 and is billed every time that someone in

The club is open to all members over 18. Bob hit his Ace at the end of the year we will begin a new program starting Opening Day. INAUGURAL QUESTION OF THE MONTH

Q. How can my friends and myself play from different tees and still have a fair game?

-Puzzled in Pittsburgh

A. Well the easiest answer is 1) choose the tees that best suits their game. 2) Find out what your handicap index is as well as your course handicap, for example we will use 9.3 (hi) and 10 as the course handicap. 3) Take the course rating and subtract the difference, example: the course rating for the Green tees is 69.7 and the White tee is 66.4. subtract and you get 3.3, round down to 3. subtract 3 if you are playing the white tees, your handicap would be 7. —Hope That Helps.—
