QUESTION OF THE MONTH
Q. Last week one of our playing partners that plays really fast hit the ball real low and hit the wall that retains the flowers and mulch in front of \#16 tee, he decided to take an ball unplayable and invoke rule 28. Is this allowed and when is it allowed?
-Interested in Irwin
A. Rule 28 states that an unplayable lie can be taken anywhere on the golf course except for in a water hazard. Therefore your speedy friend was correct, you have 3 options, line of site keeping the point where it lay between you and the hole, 2 club lengths any direction no closer to hole, or re-hit your shot from where your last shot was played (stroke and distance). The player is the only judge of whether his or her ball is unplayable.

Please bear with us as this maintenance is completed. The course will closed the first day to attend to the greens. Follow us on Twitter and Facebook to keep updated on the process and what areas the crew has covered.
