## Q-What are the requirements to play the white forward men's tees?

A-There are no age requirements used to play from any tee, even though some courses or some friends may tell you differently.

When you enter your scores into the handicap machine it will automatically change to the default tees (green for men, red for ladies). Your handicap is based on those default tees no matter what tee you play, men or women that wish to play any other tee rather than default tees will have their handicap adjusted either up or down according to which tees you wish to play.
