We will begin taking money on April Ist, and continue to grow the pot thru Opening Day. Once Opening Day arrives all that have paid in will be eligible to win half cash/half credit for a HIO. Once someone wins the original pot we will bill the next \$10 entry to your account. The stipulations are as follows:

1) HIO must take place at LCC; 2) the HIO must be witnessed by a player in your group over the age of 16.

Cart Cards-as a Member you can save a few dollars by purchasing a Cart Card for 2015. Purchase 15 carts for \$270 and receive 2 free, that's a savings of \$36. The cards will be sold thru Opening Day, you may certainly call the Golf Shop to charge to your account.

The Masters will be coming up in early April, and of course we will be running a pool starting in late March for the best golf event of the year. This year's event will be contested April 10th -13th.

First Tee-The First Tee of Pittsburgh is a non-profit organization which depends on the donations of Country Clubs and individuals to teach the good word of Golf. The programs taught at the First Tee are targeted at young people in the inner city teaching them the core values centered around Golf. We have

GHIN-If you are Golf or Social Member that does not have an established Handicap, the Golf Shop will be happy to accommodate you, contact the Golf Shop with your intention to have a **USGA** Handicap. You will be billed directly through the office a yearly charge of \$20, after 5 18 hole scores you will have your GHIN Handicap, if you are playing in an event here or at another facility most places prefer or even require that you have an updated USGA handicap.

Question of the Month

Q: The trees at Ligonier have roots that are very much in play when you hit your ball near or under, is there a root rule, is it a free drop or is it something else?

-Rooted in Ligonier

A: There is unfortunately no such thing as a root rule, you can take an unplayable lie and a) move the ball two club lengths under penalty of one stroke, b) re-hit from where you played your previous shot and add a stroke, c) keeping the point where the ball lie directly between yourself and the flag you may go back as far as you wish under penalty of one stroke. Thanks for the Question, keep them coming.

SURVEY FROM THE BOARD:

ATTENTION WINE ENTHUSIASTS

We have received comments from a number of members regarding the quality and selection of wine available for purchase at the club. Our storage capability for wines is very limited, and one of the issues with wine is that everyone has his or her preferences. Due to the comments and concerns that we have heard, and our very limited space available in the dining area, the Club is looking at the possibility of providing wine storage lockers for member's use to store their favorite wines at the club.

As we are presently thinking the program would work as follows:

- Locked wine storage bins would be located in the alcove next to the men's locker room.
- Lockers would have an individual key for the member's use only
- Lockers would hold 4 to 6 bottles of wine. Wine would be provided by the member. The club would rent the locker to the member on an annual basis (estimating \$100.00 per year)
- Member would be responsible for storing and retrieving wine bottles.
- Club would charge a corkage fee per bottle (currently \$10.00)
