Just a reminder to those planning on heading south or other locations in the next few months: Our minimum rollover policy is mainly in place to accommodate those who spend the winter months out of the area.

Please remember:

- minimums cannot be rolled into next year
- one whole month is rolled into one other month
- requests must be received in writing 15 days prior to the first month affected.

So, if you plan on being gone December your request to roll back into November needs to be in by Oct 15th, and if you're going to be gone in Nov and Dec, your request to roll back into Sept and Oct must be received in the next two weeks.
