QUESTION OF THE MONTH

I still get complaints about players touching the golf ball, not fluffing with the club, but picking up the golf ball in order to identify it.

Page 63 of the rule book talks about identifying your own golf ball which you may do only after all other methods have been exhausted (including getting down on the ground to identify), you must call over your playing companions and announce your intention to identify, pick the ball up, without cleaning and replace the ball back into its original lie. The improvement of the ball constitutes a stroke penalty. If you choose to pick up your ball to identify you have incurred a penalty of one shot. As a player you have the responsibility to protect the entire field from any breach of the

Course Aerification

Begins Tuesday after Labor Day (weather permitting)

Please bear with us as this maintenance is completed. The course will closed the first day to attend to the greens. Follow us on Twitter and Facebook to keep updated on the process and what areas the crew has covered.

The grounds crew is aiming to complete the greens and fairways in one week. Thanks to this crew, lead by John Hugo and Ron Flowers, the course has been in great shape throughout 2014. Annual aerification, though an inconvenience, is vital in providing healthy greens and fairways all year long, so that they can continue their hard and dedicated work.

Please note that the main focus of the crew during this time is aerification; other areas such as roughs and flower beds may not be attended to until the main job is completed. This is so the process may be done faster.

It takes two to three weeks for the greens to recover, but there will still be plenty of time for golf after.

MINIMUM ROLLOVER POLICY

Just a reminder to those planning on heading south or other locations in the next few months: Our minimum rollover policy is mainly in place to accommodate those who spend the winter months out of the area.

Please remember:

- minimums cannot be rolled into next year
- one whole month is rolled into one other month
- *requests must be received in writing 15 days prior to the first month affected.

So, if you plan on being gone December your request to roll

back into November needs to be in by Oct 15th, and if you're going to be gone in Nov and Dec, your request to roll back into Sept and Oct must be received in the next two weeks.


