- Pace of Play for Ligonier is 4 hours (2-hour front 9, 2-hour back 9)

Pro Tips- Volume #1.1 (2023)- THE SHANKS

Yes, I did type the word shank and said it out loud while typing this. A word no one wants to talk about; almost as bad as Harry Potter saying Voldemort. A word, feeling and shot you never want but somehow it comes at the worst possible time. How do you fix it?

Well, there's many reasons why someone may shank and getting it out of your mind is another aspect. But one simple way is to gain a feel of what it is like to hit it on the toe and heel of the clubface. How do you gain feeling or see where you're hitting it?

Answer= Foot Spray

Spray your club's face with foot spray and practice making marks on the toe and heel. You may find it hard to hit the toe but once you gain a feel, you will lose the fear of hitting it off the hosel.

You may start posting scores for handicap purposes on April 1. The handicap posting season will run through November 14.

- **REMINDER**: Scores should be posted daily as handicaps will change daily. If your score is not posted in a reasonable time, you will receive a score of PAR. The Golf Shop will happily post your scores, you may enter them online or on the GHIN APP.
- Handicaps will not be posted on the bulletin board but will be available in the Golf Shop. On Saturday's & Sunday's, handicaps will be at the starter box.
- The GHIN App can be downloaded in the Google Play Store or the Apple Store

Cap Patrol

We will once again be utilizing "Cap Patrol". Cap Patrol is part of our GHIN system and will be utilized to create a more even playing field between all. After data gathered from 2022, some will be used for tournaments this year.
