The last month has been one of continuing challenge and change at Ligonier Country Club. We were able to open the golf course on a limited basis and were able to continue to offer take-out food service for our members. We will soon begin to offer outside dining to our members and be allowed to schedule some modified golf event activity based upon government guidelines. This past week, Golf Preservations has completed the drainage project on all back-nine greens and #5 this past week. As suggested by the company, the height of the greens was raised slightly to promote proper growth and avoid scalping. This height will be kept on all 18 greens for two weeks to keep consistency throughout the course. The greens will be rolled three times per week. The proposed fairway drainage for #10 has been delayed a few weeks due to mechanical issues.

For those of you who have had the opportunity to play the course, I hope you will agree with me that we have seen immediate positive results in the quality of the golf course and we have been able to put enjoyment back in the golf experience at Ligonier Country Club.

We'd like to make sure everyone has a chance to enjoy the new greens, and so the Board is offering golf and cart for just \$25 for all guests and restricted members. Click HERE for more details and rules.

None of the above would have been possible without the support of our membership, but the essential component to this success has been the leadership and guidance of our General Manager, Bill Elliott. His ability to navigate all of the staffing issues, revenue reduction caused by the shutdown, orienting and managing staff, including a new Course Superintendent and Golf Pro, and coordinating a major construction project has been the primary reason that we have had such success to this point. I have had the opportunity to see Bill at work for quite a few years, and I am continually impressed with his ability to deal with people (both staff and members), business issues, and to constantly develop ideas to make Ligonier Country Club the best it can be. We all owe Bill a debt of gratitude and are very fortunate to have him leading the way.

As new guidance from the CDC and State of PA is issued, we will continue to modify our services to be in compliance with guidelines and to offer our members the best experience possible. The Ladies Golf Association will start organized play on Tuesday, June 2. players, with appropriate handicaps, may play in either 18 or 9-hole events using those tees.

We have made some schedule changes. On June 2, the game will be closest to the pin forever. Beat the Pro has been moved to June 9. The King & Queens event, hosted by Pat Warren, will be played on June 23. Pleases sign up in the pro shop so Pat will know how many kings are needed.

Driving Range

KEY POINTS

- RESERVATIONS REQUIRED must be made by 4pm of that day, limited number of reservations available.
- Masks must be worn to and from your table.
- Customers ARE NOT PERMITTED to move tables
 & chairs. If a larger table is required contact
 staff at least one hour prior to arrival.
- Clubhouse will close early accordingly if there are no reservations.

PROTECTING EMPLOYEES AND CUSTOMERS

All businesses and employees in the restaurant and retail food service industry authorized to conduct in person activities pursuant to this guidance must do the following:

- Follow all applicable provisions of the Guidance for Businesses Permitted to Operate During the COVID19
 Disaster Emergency to Ensure the Safety and Health of Employees and the Public, available here, including provisions requiring the establishment of protocols for execution upon discovery that the business has been exposed to a person who is a probable or confirmed case of COVID-19.
- Provide non-medical masks for employees to wear at all times and make it mandatory to wear masks
 while at the restaurant or retail food service business. An employee does not need to wear a mask if it
 impedes their vision, if they have a medical condition, or if it would create an unsafe condition in which
 to operate equipment or execute a task. Employers may approve masks obtained or made by employees
 according to Department of Health policies.
- Require all customers to wear masks while entering, exiting, or otherwise traveling throughout the
 restaurant or retail food service business. Face coverings may be removed while seated. ~~Individuals
 who cannot wear a mask due to a medical condition (including children under the age of two years per
 CDC guidance) are not required to wear masks and are not required to provide documentation of such
 medical condition.

PROTECTING EMPLOYEES AND CUSTOMERS (CONT'D)

- Provide at least six feet between parties at tables, (i.e., the six feet cannot include the space taken up by the seated guest). If tables or other seating are not movable, seat parties at least six feet apart.
- Ensure maximum occupancy limits for indoor and outdoor areas are posted and strictly enforced. Maximum occupancy is calculated using the following two methods. The more restrictive number
- Don't use shared tables among multiple parties unless the seats can be arranged to maintain six feet of distance between parties
- <u>Close or remove amenities</u> and congregate areas non-essential to the preparation and service of food or beverages such as dance floors, child play areas, interactive games, and video arcades. (<u>Bocce & Cornhole</u>)
- <u>Utilize reservations for dining on premises to maintain records of all appointments, including contact information for all customers</u>
- Allow no more than 10 people at a table, unless they are a family from the same household.
- <u>Use single-use disposable menus</u> (e.g., paper) and discard after each customer, or utilize a written posting such as a chalkboard or whiteboard to relay menu information.
- Install physical barriers, such as sneeze guards and partitions at point of sale terminals, cash registers, bars, host stands, and other areas where maintaining physical distance of six feet is difficult.

All businesses and employees in the restaurant and retail food service industry authorized to conduct in person activities in Yellow phase counties pursuant to this guidance are **prohibited** from doing the following:

- Using self-service food or drink options, such as buffets, salad bars, and condiments.
- Condiments must be removed from tables and dispensed by employees upon the request of a customer.
- Using reusable menus, other than digital menus sanitized after each use.
- Refilling food and beverage containers or implements brought in by customers.

ENFORCEMENT

<u>Failure to strictly adhere to the requirements of this guidance may result in disciplinary actions up to and including suspension of licensure, including liquor licenses.</u>

Ball must be holed out. Turn your scorecards in after the round


