## **Pro Tips- Volume #1 (2023)-**KNOW YOUR CARRY DISTANCES

-Part of "how do I lower my scores", is knowing how far you hit your clubs with a full swing.

How do I do that is what you may say. Well, a good rule of thumb would be to get shot data from a launch monitor, take 10 distances from what you think is a good shot and average them out.

Here is what my data (February) shows to give you an example. Summer data may increase.
