Welcome Back! (To the Future)

As you know by now, Governor Wolf has allowed golf courses to re-open under restricted guidelines effective May 1. We have been working over the last days and weeks to meet these guidelines in a way that inconveniences our membership in the least possible manner.

As a result, we have published <u>Guidelines</u> for our members to allow for play at Ligonier Country Club that fit both within CDC and PA requirements as well as guidance from several Pennsylvania Golf Organizations that are providing information to all golf courses in the state. Please read the Guidelines that we published through email and are posted on our <u>website</u>. Please also check in frequently as those guidelines are subject to change. We will do our best to let you know when they do.

On behalf of the Board of Governors and Club Management and Staff, we would like to thank all of our members for the support you have shown to our club, both financially and in providing moral support to our staff during these unprecedented times. I hope you will see that we are making progress on the golf course with the re-build of #12 green and the drainage project on the back nine and #5.

We would also like to thank you for your understanding of the changes we have had to make to the long-standing tradition at Ligonier of group play. Ligonier has been known through the years as a club where you can always find a game with numerous informal groups playing together in a group game. To comply with the Guidelines, we have had to eliminate that form of play for now. When officials determine that we are permitted to enter Phase Two (Restricted Programming) we should be able to return to group play in some fashion. We will let you know when that happens, although that may not be for some time.

In the meantime, stay safe, keep properly social-distancing, and enjoy the fact that we can begin to slowly return to the New Normal.



New COVID19 Policies (Highlights)

- Follow social distancing guidelines at all times.
- Do not gather in the parking lot. Any more than 8 people in an area will be asked to disband.
- As always, outside food and beverage is prohibited. Food and drinks may be ordered for the course and picked up at the clubhouse via the curbside area when available.

- There will not be bottled water available on the course.
- As of May 1st, we will be reinstating the 18% service charge on food and beverage sales. The togo fee will continue to be waived until the clubhouse is permitted to reopen.
- Only the clubhouse's main floor restrooms will be available for use during golfing hours. It will
 open and close with the pro shop. Please help us keep the area sanitized for your fellow
 members and wipe down the area after each use.
- Tee times must be made. No walk ups will be permitted. You must provide all names of your group to the pro shop when making your tee time.
- Please do not show up more than ten minutes prior to your tee time and do not linger after completion of your round to keep congregation to a minimum.
- All membership levels and guests are permitted to play according to normal policies.
- All players MUST check in with the Pro Shop before going to the first tee.
- Curbside Policies have not changed (with the exception of the 18% gratuity being reinstated)
- Birthday Coupon: due to the dine-in requirement for our birthday coupons, and that a number of you won't have the chance to use them, birthday discounts will not be offered in 2020.

From The Pro

Friday, May 1 2020; A day where we have never been so happy to say we can finally Golf. It comes at a perfect time though as the weather is getting warmer and the Golf Course is looking absolutely beautiful.

This newsletter would have had detailed information about upcoming events, but as you may have seen, all May and June events have been cancelled or postponed. We may not have these events upcoming but there is always something to talk about with the Golf operation. Below you will see information on score posting, hole-in-one club, the May Virtual Golf Bash and updated information on events and clinics. My assistant Jesse and I are looking forward to seeing everyone on the Golf Course and even we hope to get a round or two in.

Score Posting- GHIN

-SCORE POSTING WILL START ON FRIDAY, MAY 1

If you have been on the Golf Course or soon will, there are foam pool noodles protecting the cup. These are there so players are no longer reaching in the hole to remove their ball, minimizing possible exposure. So, the question is, can you still post your score if your ball is bouncing off a pool noodle and not going below the surface? The answer is YES. A round played under these conditions will result in an acceptable score for handicap purposes using the most likely score guidelines.

When using most likely score, the player should consider the number of strokes most likely required to complete the hole, and determine whether the ball would have been holed or not. Most likely score is at a player's best judgement and should not be used to gain an unfair advantage.

This is also the perfect time to download the GHIN mobile app, where you can find your handicap as well as post your score. You will need your GHIN# to log into the app so please call the Golf Shop to receive your number.

Hole-In-One Club

The tradition of the Hole-One-Club at Ligonier will continue on and all funds from 2019 will carry over. There is currently over \$800 in the pot and will be paid out (half cash, half Golf Shop credit) for the first hole in one. New for this year, whoever gets a hole-in-one and is in the club, will receive a hole-in-one plaque. Under current conditions we will not be able to start the club but as soon as the ball can go below the surface, we will start. The fee to enter will be \$10 and will be billed to your member account. When someone gets a hole-in-one, you will automatically be billed to start a new fund. Please email or call me to sign-up or check if you are already in.

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GUIDELINES DEVELOPED BY THE CDC AND PENNSYLVANIA FOR GOLF

Golf play and Tee Time information-subject to change at any time

- Golf members, social members and guests will be permitted to play
- The Golf Course will be open Tuesday through Sunday (Weekdays & Weekends)
- · The Golf Course will be completely closed to all members on Mondays until further notice
- Tee times will start at 8am (Weekdays & Weekends). All carts must be in by 7:30 pm
- ALL players must make a tee time. You can make a time online or call the Golf Shop
- There will be no group tee times nor any blocked off tee times for groups. If you make a tee time, it must be for no
 more than (4) players. Any pre-arranged or reserved group times during the week and weekend will be suspended
 until further notice
- No walk ups will be permitted
- Everyone must go off #1 tee. There will be no one starting on #10 or any other hole
- If you bring a guest, you must put his green fee and cart fee on your member account
- Time between tee times will be extended from 9 minutes to 15 minutes to ensure proper social distancing and minimize crowding prior to and following rounds
- All golfers must always maintain proper social distancing, this is mandatory, NO EXCEPTIONS
- No more than 4 players in a group
- No more than 1 person per cart even if you are cohabitating partners. First come, first serve basis
- There will be no sharing of golf carts; only 1 bag per cart. Only the person assigned the cart can use that cart
- Golf carts will be thoroughly sanitized before and after play
- CART PATH ONLY rules are in effect until further notice
- Staff will not come in contact with your personal belongings. Players will be responsible for carrying, loading, and unloading their bags
- Flags on the green will not be touched
- ONLY the restrooms in the clubhouse will be available and properly sanitized throughout the day
- Bottled water on the course and vending machines will not be available. Players are encouraged to bring their own water. Any outside food is not permitted
- Per PLCB no alcohol can be consumed on property at this time. There will be no six packs or other items sold to
 players. No congregating anywhere on property
- You MUST clean your cart out after play and dispose of everything in the garbage can by the Golf Shop. If your cart is not cleaned, your riding privileges may be suspended.

Golf Shop

- You must check in with the Golf Shop and we ask you to wear a mask
- No more than 4 people in the Golf Shop at one time
- Scorecards and pencils will be in the Golf Shop only (score posting will begin May 1- see Newsletter)
- If you are taking a cart, the Golf Shop will put a key in your cart once you check in
- If you walk 9 holes and want to ride the back 9, you must notify the Golf Shop before play and take a cart key with you. There will be a cart waiting for you on #10 with your name on it
- The Golf Shop reserves the right to close in the case of inclement weather or lack of tee times

Other

- Social distancing of six feet apart will be strictly enforced. If there is a group on the tee, the next group must wait on
 the putting green or in their car. If there is a group on the putting green, the next group must be by the front pillars or
 wait in their car. Finally, if there is a group by the pillars, you must wait in your car.
- The Range will remain closed until further notice
