#### **ICYMI from May's News:**

As we approach summer hours, we'd like to remind the membership and inform our new members of a few things:

We try to hold to the published calendar as much as possible, but as a golf course, we are beholden to the weather. We will do our best to inform you of changes to the hours and service locations as early as possible.

When service is scheduled for outside or inside, you may still dine in the other areas with **advanced** reservations.

Dinner reservations are always required by 4 pm. We reserve the right to close up to an hour early if there are no reservations, or according to play. On the flip side, we will stay open for those who will finish their round by closing time.

Take out may be limited during busy times or when we are full for reservations (often after 6 pm later in the month). You can always place a take out earlier in the day for a pick up time prior to 6 to ensure your spot.

Golf outings [have begun]. Last year we were able to keep dining service interruptions to just a few closures and always strive to have something open for the members when there are events. Please don't assume we are closed because there is an event. Be sure to regularly confer with the calendar for service location and times throughout the year. Thank you in advance for your understanding of the importance of these events to the continued operation of the club and patience with us should an event need to restrict service.

Golf outings also do not close the course all day. A larger outing can take about 5 hours on the course, so take the published shotgun time, add five hours, and you'll have an idea of when you can get out on the course afterwards. A limited number of morning tee times are generally available, first-come first-serve. Golfers will be asked to exit the course 15 minutes prior to the event's shotgun time if they are not finished.

Lastly, please remember tee times are always required. The shop may open and close according to booked tee times. See From the Pro for the current shop times.

#### **NEW- Golf Shop Major Challenges**

NEW for this year, the Golf Shop will run Fantasy Golf Pools throughout the year. We have already hosted a Master's, PGA Championship and currently the Women's US Open.

#### **RULES & INFORMATION:**

Choose 12 golfers for your team. You will see the entire field listed and broken down into divisions based on world ranking. In each grouping you will choose the specified number of players PLUS 1 alternate in case someone was to withdraw.

#### ONLY YOUR TOP 10 SCORES WILL COUNT FOR YOUR FINAL SCORE. YOUR WORST TWO OVERALL SCORES WILL BE THROWN OUT, WHICH GIVES EVEN MORE PEOPLE A CHANCE TO WIN. This will allow you to take a chance on a true wildcard if desired.

During the tournament, the Majors Challenge leaderboard updates in real-time with the actual event. Your score is the cumulative to-par score for the top 10 golfers on your team through 4 rounds. Your worst two players' scores will be thrown out.

#### Cut, Withdraw and MDF Rules:

Alternate Substitution: Teams will receive their alternate substitution if a golfer withdraws during Round 1 or 2 or decides not to play.

No Alternate Substitution: Golfers withdrawing during Rounds 3 or 4 will turn into a CUT (same as existing rule). Golfers that are DQ'd at any time during the event are also considered a cut.

If more than one golfer in a group withdraws before start of play then your team will receive an alternate for the first WD and a CUT for any additional WD.

As you will see below, you want winners, but you NEED people to make the cut

You will receive the worst four round score in place of every golfer on your squad that:

#### o is CUT or is MDF

o Withdraws in Round 3 or 4 after making the cut

#### o is Disqualified

#### All entries MUST be submitted on the website before play begins on Thursday morning.

More players may be added to the field this week, but you can adjust your team up until Thursday morning.
