## President's News March 2025

Welcome back members! The first news letter of the year, means the club is opening soon (March 7th for dining) and we can't wait to see everyone back at LCC! This year is going to be extra special. If you've lived under a rock and haven't heard yet, this is our 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary as a club! We literally could not have done it without each and every one of you. You have all been an integral part of LCC over the years and continue to help make it better and better every single year! We are unbelievably excited to show you what we have been up to this off season! The board and our amazing staff have been incredibly busy to make this season very exciting with special golf and social events, renovations to the clubhouse and so much more!

The board's objective this year is to start updating our infrastructure. We have updated the course over the last couple years and have finally reached a point that we feel the course is in a good spot so we shifted our focus to the clubhouse. Unfortunately, some of the major updates aren't visible to the naked eye, but I assure you they were done for the betterment of the club, inorder to set us up for another 100 years. Some of the updates behind the scenes are; complete overhaul of our well, water holding tanks and filter system, replacement of two upright coolers for the kitchen, new network system for the club and lastly a surge protection system for the entire club. Over the past year we have been experiencing major surges in electricity damaging several units within the clubhouse and our well system. We are working with West Penn Power to resolve that issue and have installed a surge protection system to ensure this issue won't happen again. This update was done to protect the club and also bring it up to date to help ensure the longevity of the club. Thanks to Sammy Nicklow, our House Chairman and Vice President, we were able to update our well system. Our water holding tanks had deteriorating electrical systems within it's pump and filtration systems and were in desperate need of repair. We completely overhauled that electrical system making it more reliable to help eliminate down time. Two of our upright coolers in the kitchen have been limped along and retro fitted for many years until they couldn't limp anymore. The decision was made to replace those to help eliminate food waste and extra expenses trying to fix out of date equipment.

We have also updated a lot within the clubhouse that you will be able to see! First, upon arrival at the club, you will notice a new vestibule inside our front doors. The board, Bill Elliott and staff have all done a tremendous job updating this area! Moving past the vestibule, you'll notice lots of changes to the dining room and grill room. We feel these updates will make both rooms more comfortable for everyone and encourage people to hang out and enjoy their club even more! I don't want to share too much and ruin the surprise! You'll have to see it for yourself! Lastly, you'll notice we updated the bathrooms with all new Dyson Air Hand Dryers. We wanted to do this to cut down on our paper towel consumption and costs. This was part of a big push by the board to continue to update the club and make it more efficient for many years to come!

The board recently went over the clubs rules and regulations and selected a few key points that we would like to reinforce with the membership:

- Lightning Warning is #1 first and foremost. Everyone's safety takes precedence over all else.
  - Shirt MUST be tucked in when on the golf course.
  - Absolutely ZERO outside alcoholic beverages and coolers.
    - Pace of Play must be observed.

Upon entering the proshop, every single player will be handed these bullet-points every single time to continue to remind members and guests alike of our key rules and regulations. These are non-negotiable. I can not stress enough, how incredibly important it is that we can not have outside alcoholic beverages and coolers at the club. Our liquor license depends on it. If we lose our liquor license, we lose the club and can't survive to see the next 100 years. The full updated rules and regulations will be available soon on the website under Membership > Rules.

## **Lightning Policy**

Per our insurance policy, the lightning policy will be strictly enforced. We have two sirens that blow when lightning is within our 10-mile radius: one from the clubhouse and one from the turfgrass center. If you hear these sirens, you must stop IMMEDIATELY and seek shelter or return to the clubhouse. Those that do not follow this policy will be asked to leave the Golf Course and not return.
