On behalf of the Board of Directors and our entire leadership team, it is my great pleasure to welcome you back for another exciting season at Ligonier Country Club. While we have missed seeing all of our members the last two months, our staff has been very busy updating and renovating our club, making it even better than it already was! We are very excited for everyone to see the improvements we've made as a lot of thought and hard work was put into bringing these thoughts and ideas to life. A huge thank you must go out to our wonderful staff as they have put a lot of hours and sweat into this year's renovations. They took on a huge undertaking and accomplished everything the board asked them to complete before opening the club in March. Thank you so very much to our wonderful staff, you are the heartbeat that keeps the club moving forward!

Each year, we strive to enhance the experience you value so deeply, while preserving the traditions of our club by making thoughtful improvements that elevate comfort, playability, and enjoyment for all. This past off-season has been one of meaningful progress across our facilities, and I am pleased to share several updates with you.

On the golf course, we have completed drainage improvements on #3 to enhance course conditions and playability. A new green tee box has been added on #4, offering both a refreshed look and strategic variety. Additionally, trees have been removed on #3, #16, and #18 to improve turf health, sightlines, and overall course aesthetics. The trees that were removed were deemed to be dead and needed to be removed for turf health as well as members safety around the affected areas. These enhancements reflect our ongoing commitment to maintaining a course that is both challenging and enjoyable.

Inside the clubhouse, you will notice several significant upgrades designed to improve comfort and atmosphere. The men's locker room bathroom and showers have been fully updated, providing a more modern and welcoming space reflecting what we have previously done in the women's locker room. New carpet has been installed throughout the entire clubhouse, creating a refreshed and cohesive look.

The Grill Room features new ceiling tiles, while the Pro Shop has been upgraded with new carpet, paint, and lighting to enhance your shopping and check-in experience.

In our 1925 Dining Room and front entrance, a new HVAC system has been purchased to ensure improved climate control and year-round comfort, though it will be some months until it is installed. This is reflective of our ongoing commitment to upgrading our infrastructure. We have been putting band-aids on our ageing HVAC system for years and this is the first step to upgrading that whole system. Additionally, new fans have been added in the pavilion to provide greater air flow and enhance outdoor gatherings during the warmer months.

These improvements are a direct reflection of our dedication to investing in the future of Ligonier Country Club and enriching the experience for every member and guest. Your continued support makes these enhancements possible, and we are grateful for the pride you take in our club.

As we begin this new season, I encourage you to take full advantage of all that Ligonier Country Club has to offer; exceptional golf, outstanding dining, and the camaraderie that defines our membership. We look forward to seeing you on the course, in the clubhouse, and at the many events planned in the months ahead.

**Important Updates and Reminders**

The [Rules and Regulations](#) have recently been updated.

**Food and Beverage Minimums resume in March** (unless you have selected the quarterly or spring rollover minimum options).

[Minimum rollovers](#) are restricted to Spring and Winter arrangements. See the [Rules and Regulations](#) for more information.

**To check your minimum arrangement**, log in to the member portal via the app or website and navigate to the Minimum Usage tab. There you will see the frequency, date range, and amount of requirement for the minimum. Contact the office if you believe there is an error.

You can [request to change your minimum arrangement](#) until March 15th.

**Jeans** are permitted on the course through March 31st. Jeans (in good repair) are permitted in the dining area year-round.

**General reminders:**

Dining reservations are required by 4 pm, and the clubhouse may close up to an hour early if there are no reservations. Reservations can be made at 724-238-7620 ext 2 or leave a message at ext 6. Last reservation time is a half hour before kitchen close.

There is a 48-hour cancellation notice required for all club events. If we do not receive your notice in advance, you may be charged in full for the event according to your reservation.

Outside food and beverages is prohibited on LCC property by PLCB license.

Tee times are required and Golfers must check in with the pro shop.

- All players **MUST** check in to the Golf Shop before play, even if you are Walking
- Golf Shirts Must Always Be Tucked In when entering the Golf Course
- No outside alcoholic beverages or coolers are permitted on property
- All play **MUST** begin on Hole #1 unless approved by Sean Knaus or Bill Elliott
  - Social Members- Tee times on weekends are after 1:00 PM
- Pace of Play for Ligonier is 4 hours and 15 hours (2:08 front 9, 2:07 back 9)
- When the Lightning warning or horn sounds, you **MUST** stop play and find shelter or return to the clubhouse
  - Golf Carts must be in 30 minutes before dark
- **The modified Ground Under Repair Rule between Holes #1 & #2 is no longer in effect. This area will be played "As It Lies".**

#### **Golf Shop Information/Items Member's Only Logo**

For years, we've searched for the right "Members Only" logo, something meaningful, something unique, and something that truly represents Ligonier Country Club. We often asked ourselves, What could we do that genuinely reflects who we are or the area around us?

After some digging, we realized that sometimes the perfect timing, and the perfect inspiration, has been right in front of us all along.

This year marks America's 250th Anniversary, a celebration deeply rooted in the very history that surrounds our Club. Ligonier's origins are rooted in military history, and when you think of Ligonier, you immediately think of the Fort.

Even more meaningful is the land our course sits on, the former Brandt family farm. The Brandt family was involved in the Revolutionary War, and to this day, Revolutionary-era markings and symbols remain on their family headstones in the cemetery just down the road from the Club.

All of these historic ties led us to the cannon — a symbol that represents strength, heritage, and the deep roots of both our town and our Club.

We are proud to introduce our Members Only Cannon Logo — etched deep with history and meant to be worn proudly.

## Score Posting- GHIN

Score posting will begin on Tuesday, April 1

You may post scores on the GHIN APP or leave your scorecard with the Golf Shop  
ALL scores (9 or 18) must be posted the day you play due to the PCC Calculation  
You CANNOT post a score if you have played by yourself  
During aerification, scores should still be posted per the USGA  
See below for example's on how to post scores if you do not finish an entire round.

### **13 or More Holes:**

When you play 13 or more holes, you must post an 18-hole score, even if you don't complete all 18 holes.

**Holes Not Played:** For the holes you didn't play, you'll score them as "par plus" your course handicap strokes. **Example:** If you play 14 holes and have a course handicap of 10, you'd score the remaining 4 holes as par plus 1 stroke each (because your course handicap is 10, and you're entitled to 1 stroke per hole).

### **7 to 12 Holes:**

If you play between 7 and 12 holes, you must post a 9-hole score.

**Holes Not Played:** You'll only post scores for the 9 holes you played, and the remaining holes are disregarded for handicap purpose

Play is always at your own risk.
