# 2026 Golf Season

## ***Tee Times***

Players must arrive 30 minutes prior to the posted tee time to establish groups, hear announcements, and give the Pro time to coordinate play. Late arrivals will be placed wherever there is an opening.

### **18-Holers**

**10:00 a.m.**      **April, May, September**

**9:30 a.m.**      **June, July, August**

### **9-Holers**

**11:00 a.m.**      **April, May, September**

**10:30 a.m.**      **June, July, August**

9-Holers are welcome and encouraged to come early and participate.

***DUES:*** The Association dues are \$65.00. You will not be eligible to win a prize until dues are paid and you have an established handicap.

***HANDICAPS:*** New Association members can establish a handicap by having a minimum of three scores (54 holes), in 9- or 18-hole segments.

**Note:** You can play nine holes one day and nine holes another day and combine them for an 18-hole score. Handicaps will be taken care of through the Pro Shop using The World Handicap System. Your new handicap is available in the Pro Shop.

**18-Holers:** There must be six golfers competing to make a legitimate event. If the event is called off for any reason, no scores will count for the event of the day. However, Ringers may be posted.

**9-Holers:** There must be three golfers competing to make a legitimate event. If the event is called off for any reason, no scores will count for the event of the day. However, Ringers may be posted.

**Tee Options:** The USGA encourages players to select a tee that best matches their playing ability. The proper slope and course rating of the Red/Orange Combo and Orange tees have been established for the Ladies.

Whether playing 18 or 9 holes on Tuesdays, players have three options:

- Red tee
- Red/Orange Combo
- Orange tee

If your handicap index is greater than 40.4 from the Red tee, you must play the Orange tee on Ladies Association Days.

Handicaps will be adjusted based on the tee selection. The Pro Shop must be notified of your tee selection at the time you sign up for play to ensure that teams are properly balanced.

The Queen Bee and Ladies Classic must be played from the Red tees. The Lady Bug and Forward Tee Classic will be played from the Orange tee.

***ORGANIZATION OF PLAY:*** The Pro Shop determines groupings for regular and special events play.

### ***SIGNING UP FOR TUESDAY PLAY:***

Use the on-line tee time system or call the Pro Shop **by Sunday at 6 p.m. prior to Tuesday**. This will help organize the groups, especially for team games.

***SCORES & SCORECARD:*** When your round is complete, make sure that your scorecard is signed, verified, dated, and turned into the Pro Shop.

***WORKING GIRLS:*** You must inform the Pro Shop before teeing off on Saturday or Sunday that you are playing for the next Tuesday event. Have your scorecard properly signed, dated, and turned into the Pro Shop. Record your Ringers in the Locker Room.

**Note:** You may only play on the weekend prior to a Tuesday you will be working.

**Exception:** Special events must be played on the scheduled day.

**BEAT THE PRO**

Individual event. Your best Net score against the Pro's scratch score. The Pro will rotate playing with each group for several holes. The Pro gets two mulligans of his choice.

**August 25**

**BEST POKER HAND**

Individual Event.

Each player will receive one (1) card to start their round. On each hole, players may gain a card by obtaining a NET par or 1-Putt. At the end of the round, players will stop in the Golf Shop to claim their cards and determine their Poker Hand. Best Poker Hand wins.

**September 1**  
**Tuesday**

**BEST APPROACH**

Individual Event.

All players get on the green, with their last shot to the green's surface, the player:

- Closest to the hole = 3 pts.
- Second closest = 2 pts.
- Third closest = 1 pt.
- Farthest away = 0 pts.

Most points win.

## *Adjusting Scores For Handicap*

The maximum hole score for each player will be limited to a **Net Double Bogey** when posting a handicap score. The calculation will be Par of the hole, plus 2 strokes, plus any handicap strokes you receive on that hole. For example, if you get 2 strokes on the number 1 hole (Par 5), your maximum score for that hole would be a 9 (Par 5 + 2 + your 2 handicap strokes = 9).

When playing in a competitive event, the actual score must be recorded on the card for determining the gross and net score. If you take 10 strokes on number 1, that is the score that goes on the card for the event. The Pro Shop will make the adjustments when entering handicap scores.

# *Local Rules*

## ***NUMBER 12 RULE***

If your tee shot on #12 goes in the water, walk across to the drop area, 2<sup>nd</sup> shot is a penalty—hit 3<sup>rd</sup> shot from the marked drop zone beyond the water.

## ***OUT OF BOUNDS***

The course-side, inside edge, of the fence posts on holes #5 and #17 define the boundary of the course. A ball is out of bounds when all of it is outside the boundary edge of the course.

## ***SCREEN RULE***

Since the screens are protective, they will be played in this fashion: move the ball to the closest side until you have an unobstructed view of the pin. You may proceed to drop the ball, no closer to the hole, with no penalty.
